QUESTION ASKED--

When is the best time to feed your dog??

Last week I posted an article from a trainer about feeding your dog and the best time to do it. I should have read it closer (it was from a trusted source so I used the info). I agree with these experts and our trainer Ben Garcia and feeding once a day is not a good idea. A high protein and high fat diet for hard working dog is the preferred option. We feed Purina and Loyal to all of our dogs. There are many good dog foods out there, and they can get expensive, but you are better off feeding a quality food than junk (more poop and less nutrition)

Drs Jeff Fowler, Skip Brod, Todd Rezac, Bill Willhoit, and Matt Demey all agree that feeding one time a day is not a good practice, especially for a hard working hunting dog. Twice a day is best and feeding them a couple hours prior to hunting and again after hunting (once they have cooled down and rested a bit) is a perfect practice.

HOW TO MAKE RESERVATIONS TO HUNT AT YOUR CLUB



Here are the rules for you to make a reservation. Remember that we have a 48 hour cancellation policy. IF weather is so bad that it is unsafe to get to the club, we will cancel the hunt and will call you. We do not want to endanger anyone, but we hunt in all sorts of weather.

If you call the office to make reservations, please speak slowly and leave your phone

number....believe it or not we have more than one John or Jim as members!

The only number you call to make reservations is the office--719-635-3257. If it is after hours during the week, leave a message and we will call you the next business day. (Don't call the clubhouse to make reservations....please!)

You can call the office 7 days a week to make reservations by phone at 719-635-3257.

You will either get a live person or a voice mail.

You can also make reservations by email. Email hunt@rmroosters.com

When you email a reservation, we will reply to you to confirm the reservation. You need to tell us how many hunters are in your group, if you will need a guide (are you hunting with your own dog or not) and what birds you want to shoot....Pheasants or Chukar or BOTH. A mixed bag is a lot of fun and you don't have to care about what gets up to shoot at.

Do not email hunting reservations after 5pm on Friday....weekends. We don't always look at email during the weekends. Call our main number--719-635-3257-- and again you will get a live person or a voice mail. Leave a message and we will call you back.

EMAIL OR PHONE...THOSE ARE THE TWO WAYS TO MAKE RESERVATIONS. DO NOT CALL THE CLUBHOUSE TO MAKE RESERVATIONS USE THE MAIN NUMBER--719-635-3257

There is a 48 hour cancellation policy.

We can not take more than 4 people in a party NO EXCEPTIONS!!

The guide fee is \$50 per group, not per person. 1 to 4 hunters.

Hunts start at 8 and run until 11am or from 1 to 4pm.

CANCELLATIONS OR RESERVATIONS AFTER HOURS OR ON THE WEEKENDS--

Cancellations-- you must call so we are 100% sure we get the message that you can't make your hunt. Don't email or text (we don't do texts)

Reservations--Call the main number and we will get back with you as soon as we get the message.

REMEMBER!!! DON'T EMAIL RESERVATIONS AFTER 5PM FRIDAY UNTIL 8AM MONDAY. We don't see email on weekends.
