

SNOW GOOSE HUNTING

The late snow goose season is just starting and runs into April. Dan Paull with Wild By Nature has a great opportunity for hunters that want to put a bunch of the white birds in the freezer.

For \$175 per gun you can hunt all day and there is no limit on snow geese. This is a guided hunt and includes overnight lodging. The hunt is in western Nebraska and it can be very good if the weather and the birds cooperate.

BIG GAME APPS ON LINE

Some of you apply for big game licenses in Colorado and in other western states.

If you are applying for licenses, it is time to get after it.

Arizona--Elk and Antelope apps are done but Deer and Sheep are going to come up soon and you can access them at www.azgfd.gov/draw

Utah--You have until March 1st for all species. www.utah-hunt.com

Colorado--If you hunt big game in Colorado, you can apply on line now, and you should have received the regs in the mail. You have until April 3rd to get your chances in for the draws.

Montana--Apps are due by March 15. <https://app.mt.gov/Als/Index>

New Mexico--If you are going to try and draw with the RMR hunters we need to get you the outfitter draw info and we will apply with/for you. Email me for the app at hunt@rmroosters.com

If you want to try and get a Desert Sheep in the USA, New Mexico has added 13 tags that you can draw for. Go to <http://www.wildlife.state.nm.us> and apply. It takes a chunk of change to apply, but your odds are way better than they have ever been.

One thing that a lot of hunters miss out on are the raffles that each state does for fundraising. You actually have better odds of winning a raffle in many cases than of drawing. Check out each states website to see who is raffling what.

The Colorado Chapter of SCI has a Moose license and a statewide Deer tag they are raffling off. www.scicolorado.org They will draw March 10 at the dinner. Come to dinner too!



DO YOU WANT TO HUNT TURKEYS THIS YEAR??

Here is an opportunity for the RMR folks to go Turkey hunting and shoot 3 birds!

This hunt takes place on over 15000 acres of private land in Nebraska and it is close to home. You can harvest 3 turkeys per person during this hunt and the season is a long one.

He guarantees your hunt and if you don't have a shot at a mature Tom you come back on him for free. This hunt is fantastic for kids and first timers, but all of his hunts are guided so you will see a lot of birds. All private land and a super deal.

MOOSE IN BRITISH COLUMBIA



Don Johnson (above) can tell you that it is a great hunt. The first full day of his 2011 Moose hunt in BC ended up being a long one since he had to have a ton of pictures taken and he needed to take care of his meat and trophy. The story got better as an even bigger bull stayed outside his cabin for 8 hours then next day and taunted him with a cow in heat.

RMR is going back again to the beautiful mountains of British Columbia to hunt Moose, Caribou and Grizzly Bear. We would love to have you go with us this year or plan to come with us in 2013. We have many members that can give you the skinny on the hunt and if you want to shoot a Moose, this is the place.

We will be going in September and October and there are a few...and I really mean a few...spots open for this fall. Russell Cummins runs a first class operation and the opportunity for a big bull is the best I have ever found in North America. He also has fantastic Stone Sheep and Mountain Goat in his area.

One of the greatest benefits about this hunt is that we bring all of the meat, antlers and hides back in a freezer semi-trailer. Moose meat is the best big game meat, in my opinion, and that is a trophy for the freezer and you will get one for the wall too!

DEER-ELK-ANTELOPE IN NEW MEXICO

We have been hunting with Roger and Audrey McQueen and Trophy Ridge Outfitters in New Mexico for many years and they run a quality operation for sure. New Mexico is a state where all non-resident hunters have to draw a license in the lottery, they take care of all of the applications and the permit process. If you can draw a license, there are good opportunities for trophy animals.

The hunts are fully guided with meals and lodging, but you have to draw a tag to hunt. The Elk hunts are \$4250 and the Mule Deer hunts are \$3950, plus licenses.

If you would like to apply to hunt in New Mexico with Trophy Ridge and RMR, call the office or email us and we will get you all of the information necessary to get in the drawing. Applications **need to be done and into us by March 1st, 2012.**

They also offer some of the best Pronghorn Antelope hunting in the west! You have to

have a hunters safety card to apply for licenses in New Mexico and they take archery, rifle and muzzleloader hunters. The Pronghorn hunts are \$1750.

Seasons are Sept-Nov 2012.
