

GUN SAFETY CLASSES SET--GET YOUR CONCEALED CARRY!


We have not changed our approach to teaching the basic and intermediate gun safety classes. The number of people that have been 'thinking' about taking the class and actually doing it has increased, but don't let a punk scare you into doing the right thing. Do it because it is the right thing and the right time. We have the right to carry concealed in Colorado, with the proper permit, but we have the duty and responsibility to know how to handle firearms safely.

The Basic Pistol Class is a ONE DAY-8 hour class and you will get the certificate so you can get your concealed carry permit. You only have to take the class one of these days and the cost is only \$80 per person. There are 12 spots in each class.

AUGUST 18 and AUGUST 19 are the dates for the Basic Pistol Class. (Two classes)

The next intermediate class date is September 8. Again, a one day class, but you must have taken one of RMR's basic classes or have your CCW to take the intermediate class. Cost is \$200 and there are 8 people per class on those dates.

DOG TRAINING DAY---TRAIN WITH THE TRAINER--- PUPPIES AND OLDER DOGS ARE WELCOME FOR THESE CLASSES

RMR is fortunate to have a full time dog trainer on site and Ben Garcia and Hideaway Kennels will be hosting a Train with the Trainer day August 4th.

There are three different classes that you can attend (and bring your dogs too....that is what this is for after all!) You can attend all three or just one, but you have to sign up to attend.

Class 1

8am to 10am- bird introduction. This is open to all ages of dogs. We will introduce them the proper and safe way!

Class 2

10:30am to 12noon- Gun Introduction. This is open to all ages of dogs. We will introduce dogs to the sound of guns.

Class 3

1pm to 2:30pm- E Collar Introduction. This is designed for dogs 6 months or older. We will introduce dogs to the e-collar and show owners how to properly use this training tool.

Training will take place at the Dog Training Area of RMR. \$20 per each session or \$50 for the whole day. Includes the cost of birds.
