

SPORTSMEN AGAINST HUNGER


**Did you know that 1 pound of meat

GIANT CHUKAR AND QUAIL HUNTS

Cost of the GIANT QUAIL HUNT is \$950 and there are only 18 hunts LEFT for this fall. Quail hunts take place between September 15 and December 15 ONLY. Non-member cost of the Giant Quail hunt is \$1250.

Cost of the GIANT CHUKAR HUNT is \$1800 and these take place between October 1 and December 31. REMEMBER---there are only 15 of these left to use. RMR MEMBERS and their GUESTS ONLY!!! Sorry...not available to non-members at this price. (Non-member price is \$4000)
