

HUNTING ON PUBLIC LANDS AT RISK!!

You may have seen the news that the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS), along with other anti-hunting groups and individuals, filed a petition with the Interior Department demanding rules against hunting with traditional ammunition on public lands - one-fifth of the total land area in the U.S.

We warned this was coming after their playbook was discovered. After all, this is the same HSUS that is run by Wayne Pacelle, who has made his goals known:

"If we could shut down all sport hunting in a moment, we would." (The Kingman Daily Miner, 30 December 1991).

"We are going to use the ballot box and the democratic process to stop all hunting in the United States. We will take it species by species until all hunting is stopped in California. Then we will take it state by state." (Full Cry Magazine, 1 October 1990).

The 50 page-petition is littered with junk science and fails to make the case that the use of traditional ammunition is a threat to wildlife populations or to humans that would warrant such a drastic action. Are we really to believe USUS finds hunting acceptable just so long as hunters use alternative ammunition? Hunters, sportsmen and target shooters aren't gullible. We know better than to trust HSUS with setting hunting policy for the entire country. But we can't assume the Obama Administration's Interior Department is on our side.

Call Interior Secretary Sally Jewell today at 202-208-3181 and tell her to reject this scientifically baseless petition from HSUS to ban traditional ammunition. Let the Department of the Interior know that requiring the use of alternative, non-lead ammunition, is nothing more than a back-door way to ban hunting by raising the price of participating in an

American sporting tradition. Make sure to tell them:

- There is no sound science to support banning traditional ammunition used by hunters for centuries.
- Don't allow the Humane Society and other anti-hunting groups to advance their end game of banning all hunting through the tactic of by banning the use of traditional ammunition for hunting on public lands.
- There is absolutely no adverse wildlife population impact that warrants such a drastic measure.
- There is no evidence that consuming game taken with traditional ammunition poses a human health to hunters and their family.
- Hunters are the original conservationists. Excise taxes (11%) raised from the sale of traditional ammunition the HSUS and others unfairly demonize is a primary source of wildlife conservation funding. Banning traditional ammunition will harm the very animals HSUS claims to care about.

GIANT QUAIL AND CHUKAR HUNTS FOR FALL 2014

The fall hunting season is just around the corner and we intend to open for hunting on September 13th. As usual, we will hunt the mornings only until the weather allows safe hunting for the dogs (heat issues).

We will still have our GIANT QUAIL HUNTS and we have
20 --and ONLY TWENTY-- GIANT CHUKAR HUNTS.

Both of these hunts are all day events with up to 4 hunters. A guide and dogs are provided, but you can do this with your own dogs, too! (This is an awesome day for folks with their own dogs...bird overload!!) You can harvest 100 birds on each of these hunts.

Cost of the GIANT QUAIL HUNT is \$950 and there are only 20 hunts left for this fall. Quail hunts take place between Sept 15 and Dec 15 ONLY

Cost of the GIANT CHUKAR HUNT is \$1800--**SAVINGS OF \$500** --and these

take place between October 1 and December 31. **REMEMBER---**there are only **TWENTY** of these to use. **RMR MEMBERS** and their **GUESTS ONLY!!!**

GUN SAFETY CLASSES BEGINNER AND INTERMEDIATE ARE GOING GANGBUSTERS!!



The **basic pistol class** starts at the very beginning and is perfect for those that might not have ever fired a weapon. This is truly a gun safety class and after completion of the course, you can get your concealed carry permit if you chose to do so. The cost is still only \$90 and the class is a one day course, and you will actually shoot handguns (unlike many other courses and much more

extensive than other 'hotel' classes) You will need 50 rounds of ammo for this class or you can rent a firearm with ammo for \$25.

The **RMR Intermediate Pistol Course** is the next step in training and education. This course is for those that have already taken the RMR Basic Pistol Course or already have their concealed carry permit. This class teaches the students how to draw from a holster and address multiple targets as well as moving targets. You will also learn ammunition management, how to deal with gun malfunctions, tactical and emergency reloading and eventually drawing a handgun from concealment.

The Intermediate class is \$225 and you must have a semi-automatic pistol 3 magazines, an outside the waistband holster, magazine pouch and a minimum of 300 rounds of ammunition.
