

MAKING RESERVATIONS TO HUNT



We are getting into the season and we can go over how you can make reservations to hunt at your club.

The only number you call to make reservations is the office-- 719-635-3257. If it is after hours during the week, leave a message and we will call you the next business day. (Don't call the clubhouse to make reservations....please!)

You can call the office Monday - Friday, 8am-5pm and make reservations by phone at 719-635-3257.

You can also make reservations by email. Email hunt@rmroosters.com

When you email a reservation, we will reply to you to confirm the reservation. You need to tell us how many hunters are in your group, if you will need a guide (are you hunting with your own dog or not) and what birds you want to shoot....Pheasants or Chukar or BOTH. A mixed bag is lots of fun and you don't have to care about what gets up to shoot at.

Do not email hunting reservations after 5pm on Friday....weekends. We don't always look at email during the weekends. Call the office number and it will direct you to the clubhouse, if we are not in the office to get your call.

REMEMBER!!!


There is a 48 hour cancellation policy.

We can not take more than 4 people in a party NO EXCEPTIONS!!

The guide fee is \$50 per group, not per person. 1 to 4 hunters.

Hunts start at 8 and run until 11am or from 1 to 4pm.

Save On Your Utility Bills

If you're willing to look little deeper at your budget, you can find areas that will allow for some additional savings, and one great place is in your utility bills.

Control Your Water Usage. One way to save money on water usage is to identify and fix leaks in faucets and toilets. Other ways include taking a shower rather than a bath and operating the dishwasher and washing machine only when loads are at full capacity. (Someone said show with a friend...spouse I assume!!)

Keep an Eye on the Temperature of Your Hot Water Heater. While many guides call for your hot water heater to be set at up to 140°, reducing that setting may save you some money. For each 10° you lower your water heater, you can save between \$12 and \$30 annually.

SAVE \$50 on Your Goose Hunting



Travis Reininger and the gang from **STILLWATER OUTFITTERS** are ready to start whacking the geese and ducks for the 2015-16 season.

Travis is still giving the RMR folks a great discount for the hunts again this year....but you must make a reservation to hunt before October 31st to get the discount. His price for the waterfowl hunts is \$250, but RMR folks will save \$50 per gun if you book a date between now and the end of the season, which is February 14, 2016.

You don't have to hunt before the 31st of October to get the discount, but you do have to make a reservation to hunt.

How about the other health problems that we might **SHARE....very interesting!**

THE BEST DEFENSE IS NOT SUBMISSION

Yesterday there was another mass shooting in a gun free zone at a college in Oregon. At this time there are 9 dead people plus the POS that shot them. More might die from their wounds. I pray that doesn't happen.

Scott and I teach gun safety and Intermediate and Advanced pistol shooting and self defense, and one of the things we teach folks from the beginner course to the most advanced is that the best defense is to fight back and **NEVER EVER SUBMIT!** Scream, kick, punch, shoot, get others involved...something but do not ever give up and give in. If you are going to die anyway, die fighting. A very high percentage of handgun wounds are not lethal and you have a better chance of surviving an attack by fighting back than waiting for the bad guy to put you in a trunk or throw you off of a building or putting a bullet in your head.

Here is a good video that all young people--**HECK, EVERYONE--** should watch,

especially women. It is one of many that remind you to pay attention. It is called situational awareness.

Take a class with us next spring and summer. **DON'T BE A VICTIM.**
Please pray for those families and victims who are suffering from this tragic event.

"When I die I will dig my way up and out of the grave to come back and haunt you for the rest of your life!"


Well he died abruptly under strange circumstances and the funeral had a closed casket.
