

## **SAFETY and COMMON SENSE**

**Everyone has a built in safety...  
right between your ears!**



Kids don't remember  
their best day of  
television.

We have been guiding hunters for almost 30 years and we have had a very good safety track record. We have to stay vigilant when it comes to safety. You might have been hunting for 50 years, but it is a blink of an eye for a careless act to take place. The only person responsible for an accident is the person shooting the gun. It isn't the guides fault or the birds fault it is the person holding the shotgun that has the ultimate responsibility for the shot.

**Don't blow off our safety speech because you have heard it before. Make sure your guests and kids know that you cannot call a shot back. Make them well aware that if you wound a dog it will cost you \$2500 plus vet bills and if you kill a dog it will cost you \$10,000. You sign that agreement as a member and all of your family and guests do the same. If you don't want to agree to those terms, go find another club to hunt at or don't hunt at all.**

You cannot shoot a bird on the ground. PERIOD. You are not allowed to shoot rabbits at RMR either. PERIOD. Dogs don't fly. Neither do rabbits. **DO NOT SHOOT BIRDS ON THE GROUND.** If you do, the hunt is over. PERIOD.

**We have a blue sky rule.** That is simple. The birds have to be up and away from the dogs in the blue sky. If they are above your head in the sky, you won't shoot a dog. If they aren't above the dogs and in the air....**DON'T PRESS THE TRIGGER!!!!**

We hunt with our safeties on. You can take the safety off as you mount the gun and then take the shot. Put the safety back on when you are done shooting. Not when you are done reloading. You are asking for an accidental discharge. Nothing is worth a bird....or a dog or God forbid a person.

A couple of other issues that we need to address again (and we should not have to!!) **DO NOT CROSS FENCES** onto neighbors land. The private land is marked and we do not have permission to hunt on their land, unless we tell you so. If a bird drops on the private land, handle your dog to retrieve it or **ONE PERSON** leave your gun and go get it with a dog.

**No driving in the fields or on the roads.** When you are assigned an area you **MUST** park in the designated parking area. That is where your vehicle stays. When you are done hunting, unload your gun and go back to the clubhouse. Do not stop along the way and shoot more birds because you see them. That isn't your area and you cannot shoot birds off of the county roads or outside of your assigned hunting areas. **Shooting from the county road is illegal** and I will revoke your membership if any one of us catches you.

We take safety in the field very seriously and my guides have full authority in the field to make sure you have a safe and productive hunt. If you violate the rules, they will shut the hunt down. **Bill and I back our staff 100%.**

If you are running your own dogs, don't get any more lax about safety. Drill the same rules into your guests' heads and make sure they don't shoot low or on the ground. We don't want ANY DOGS shot or killed. Ours or yours.

**Nothing larger than 6 shot.** 7 1/2 is fine for shooting birds over dogs. Leave the 4's and 5's at home.

Scott Axton and I teach handguns safety classes as well as Intermediate and Advanced tactical courses all summer. In our classes we talk about a SQUIB LOAD. You can talk about it all day long, but until you see one or have one yourself, it is all hearsay. If it happens and it goes bad, you could have what we call an UNINTENTIONAL DIS-

ASSEMBLY OF A FIREARM. Watch the video and see what a SQUIB LOAD looks and sounds like.
