

What an amazing run we continue to enjoy. Colorado's Finest Private Hunting Club is getting ready to **start shooting birds on September 19th** and this is the start of our 30th year providing you with the best in upland hunting.

I had a great hunt for Stone's Sheep in British Columbia in August. Below you will see some pictures and a short story. A longer version will follow, but this will answer the questions that have been coming in...YES I DID GET ONE!

The dove hunting started on the first of September, and it will continue to be available FREE for members and only \$30 for your guests and family, per day. You must have a small game license and you will need to call and let us know you are coming. We will shoot the little grey rockets until the season is over or they are gone.

We are starting to take reservations and people are thinking ahead for the holidays, and that is a good thing! The day after Thanksgiving is a busy one, and that day ONLY we have a two person minimum for hunts so we can accommodate all of you and your families on that one day. The Saturday and Sunday of that weekend you can hunt solo if you want to.

FOURTH TIME IS A CHARM

August 23, 2015 I was able to harvest the last ram of the North American Sheep species. It was the 18th anniversary of my Dads passing. Ralph was with me in spirit the whole hunt. This was my 4th attempt at Stone Sheep and was by far the hardest and the most satisfying sheep hunt I have been on. Thanks to my wife and her support to go for the 'last one', I did it.

The cliff notes version of the hunt (more later)....I rode 180 miles on horseback and climbed 40 miles to get this ram on the afternoon of the last day of the hunt. He is a screwy ram...I called him "Cockeyed" due to his right side being damaged, probably from a fall when he was four years old.

If you need a Stone Sheep, Pelly Lake Outfitters is the best outfit I have been with for these sheep. We saw 17 rams and the horses and camps are first class.

Here are a few pictures and I will have a story with some more details later, but I wanted to get this out with the other club information! (that is more important, but this will stop the emails and calls to see if I really got one this time!)





HOUSEKEEPING AND HUNTING

It is the start of a new year and here is the information for making reservation and for the hunting at your club.

***You can make reservations by email at hunt@rmroosters.com or by phone at 719-635-3257. If you book by email, we will respond to you with an email confirmation. Make sure you tell us all of the details regarding your hunt request. Do you need a guide and dogs, what day of the week and date, what time**

--morning or afternoon, how many hunters and what you want to hunt ie:pheasant or chukar or a mixed bag.

***Shot size is still nothing larger than 6 shot. 7 1/2 is a perfect shot size for these birds. You can use 6's, 7.5, or 8 shot.**

***Hunts still start at 8a and run until 11a or from 1p until 4p.**

***We can not take more than 4 people in a guided group. PERIOD. This year we are not making exceptions. If you have 5 or more, we will split you into 2 or more groups.**

***New this year: If you need a guide and dogs, there is a \$50 fee per group - not per person- and this is for 1-4 hunters. (WHY?? We have been the ONLY club in the state not to charge for guides and dogs, and the workman's comp and other insurance has escalated more than 70% in the past few years. We still pay our guides, but this is keeping us from having to raise the price of the hunts)**

***No drinking before or during shooting. When you are done hunting, come back to the clubhouse and have a cold one. Please don't leave empty beer cans in the trash cans in the field.**

***The trash cans at the parking areas are for empty shells, not for you to clean out your truck and the fast food bags.**

***No smoking in the field or in the clubhouse or chophouse. We don't need a fire!**

***Pick up your empty shells, and if you can't find yours, pick up the ones you see. It helps keep a cleaner hunting area and we appreciate it.**

***We are closed on Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter.**

***You are responsible for your guests and their behavior. We like you to bring your friends, family and clients with you. Make sure they sign the liability release when they come in and that they have orange head gear.**

***Safety is the most important thing that we practice at the club. We have a BLUE SKY RULE....do not shoot any bird on the ground. It has to be flying and in the 'blue sky' and up and away from the dogs. If you shoot a dog, it will get very expensive for you. These dogs are your family and our family. PLEASE PLEASE pay attention to where you are shooting! If you are on a guided hunt, our guides have the right to stop a hunt for any safety violation. You only have one chance to make a mistake that could cost a life and the stopping of the hunt. PAY ATTENTION. You will hear the safety speech each time you hunt, and have your guests watch the safety video before you go into the field.**

Cost of the GIANT QUAIL HUNT is \$950 and there are only 18 hunts LEFT for this fall. Quail hunts take place between September 15 and December 15 ONLY. Non-member cost of the Giant Quail hunt is \$1250.

Cost of the GIANT CHUKAR HUNT is \$1800 and these take place between October 1 and December 31. REMEMBER---there are only 15 of these left to use. RMR MEMBERS and their GUESTS ONLY!!! Sorry...not available to non-members at this price. (Non-member price is \$4000)
